I first met our foster failure in the summer of 2015 when I was a volunteer dog walker. As I drove into the parking lot early one morning, I saw a funky-looking, hodge-podge colored dog in an outside kennel. I couldn't resist going

into the kennel to introduce myself. He did all the expected things that shelter dogs usually do to garner attention, including the "take-me-I-will-be-your-perfect-companion" look. Yup—they can really bore into one's psyche with those looks.

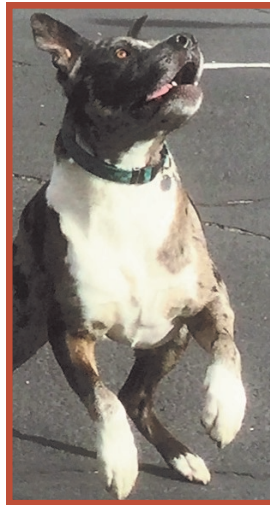
Finley was a year old at that time, friendly, energetic and eager to please. I found that out by walking him on my shift and post-shift visits, and that got me to thinking that in conjunction with dog-walking, I could occasionally foster dogs. I talked with my wife and mentioned the possibility of fostering a dog for a week or so at a time. It had been five years since our last dog passed away, so she was suspicious that I might be attempting to sneak a dog into our quiet existence. I assured her that my intentions were noble and that I just wanted to provide a respite for shelter denizens and some training to help make them more adoptable. Happily, she bought into what now seems like the elaborate ruse she always suspected.

Finley seemed to be a good candidate for the first foster attempt, so I made all the arrangements to become part of the foster program. When I received the go-ahead for fostering, Finley was still around. So there I was, clumsily buckling Finley into the back of the car to head out to his new temporary home.

I kept him for a fun-filled week before returning him to the shelter. He did not want to go back and showed this by frenetic, high-pitched yelping. *Oh yeah, I*

*thought, I did you a favor and now you're foisting this guilt thing on me.* Impervious to such cajolery, off I went, satisfied that I had done my part to help out this forlorn, stranded dog.

Soon after I returned him, Finley got in a ruckus with his kennelmate and was beaten up a bit, sustaining some injuries to his face and ears. When I told my wife about it, she reluctantly agreed to accept him back in our home for some convalescing; but again, she had her suspicions.



After a week of caring for him, I was halfheartedly on my way to return him, but stopped to have coffee at one of my usual spots. When I was ready to leave, I saw a woman holding a phone walking toward me through the parking lot. *That looks like my wife,* I thought. Indeed it was, and when she got to my table, she gave me the phone and asked me to call the Animal League to tell them we wanted to keep Finley permanently.

Finley has been with us now for over two years. With a lot of love, attention and some training, he has become an ideal family member. He is very affectionate, obedient and friendly, plus being a good watch dog. Playing ball is his favorite activity though he literally will jump at the chance for **any** fun offered.

Just to set the record straight, I did not *intentionally* finesse Finley into our foster failure family. Chalk it up to canine karma and his golden-brown, hypnotic eyes that sealed the deal. Or just maybe, after five years of not having a dog, we were destined to be foster failures.

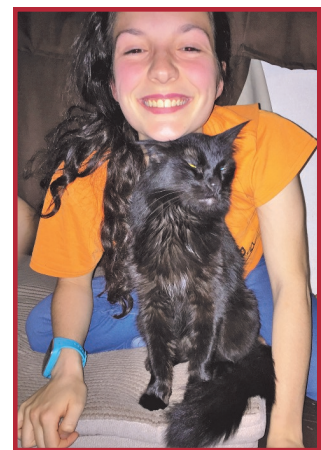
## A Cat's Tale

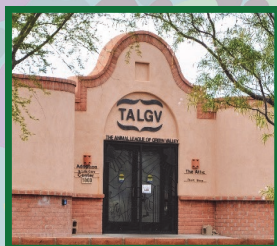
